Enquiries in Edmonton, Alberta, disclose that the flight taken by the CAPOLINO brothers was booked on August 3, 1965 in New York City. It is presumed that the booking of this flight was made through the Air Canada office in New York, as enquiries reveal that there is an Air Canada flight from New York to Edmonton via Toronto, Ontario. The C.P.A. flight on September 16 left Toronto at 7:40 a.m. and arrived in Edmonton at 11:40 a.m.

2. Investigation indicated that the CAPOLINO brothers only stayed in Edmonton for a matter of a few hours to make connection with their flight to Prince George, B.C. It was established that the C.P.A. flight for Prince George leaves Edmonton at 5:00 p.m., arriving in Prince George at approximately 7:30 p.m.
