Re Baheau letter to New York, dated 1/28/63, captioned "THE CRIMINAL COMMISSION ET AL; ANTI-RACKETEERING -CONSPIRACY."

This investigation was predicated on information furnished by NY 169-C, on December 12, 1957, that JOHN PAGANO operated for TODDO MARINO, who was connected with AUGIE CARFANO, and later with JOE ADONIS.

The files of the N. Y. Division reflect on 6/5/47, JOHN JOSEPH/PAGANO, THOMAS ALOYSIUS MARINO aka Toddo Marino, and PETER MINAFO were arrested by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, at Brooklyn, N. Y., for the Intimidation of a Government Witness relative to a case which was on trial, at that time, in the U. S. District Court, Eastern District of New York. PAGANO resided at 155 67th Street, Brooklyn, N.Y. and was listed as the owner of the Marine Bar and Grill, 718 Third Ave., Brooklyn, N.Y. He was born on 11/23/90.

On 12/1/58, the records of the Department of Health, Brooklyn, N.Y., reflected that JOHN PAGANO, 155 67th St., Bklyn., N.Y., occupation - bar and grill manager, died of natural causes on 4/21/57, at Holy Family Hospital, Bklyn., NY. JOSEPT (GANO

On 5/24/63, NY 169-C identified a photograph of JOHN JOSEPH, taken at the time of his arrest on 6/5/47, as the individual previously identified by him as being under TODDO MARINO. Accordingly, this case is being closed in the NYO.
