On August 10, 1964, Miss O'NEILL of the United States Probation Office, Chicago, advised that CHRISTINE WELSH, presently on Federal parole, and under the supervision of Miss O'NEILL, is living with the subject in the Franklin Manor Apartments, Franklin Park, Illinois. They are in apartment C at 3034 Prairie, Franklin Park. On the first occasion that Miss O'NEILL attempted to verify this residence, she attempted to make a contact in the evening accompanied by a male associate. She inquiried at the office as to the apartment in which CHRISTINE WELSH and the subject lived, and was refused this information by a person apparently associated with management of the apartments. Miss O'NEILL stated this man's attitude was very belligerent and itewaswobviousotolher that he was not cooperative even though she subsequently identified herself as a Probation Officer. On other occasions Miss O'NEILL noted late model expensive automobiles parked in front of apartment C, and observed well-dressed businessmen entering and leaving this apartment. Miss O'NEILL also noted from the records of her office that a psychiatric examination at Alderson indicated that CHRISTINE WELSH was described as a schizoid personality with a psychopathic type schizoid trend. She also noted that CHRISTINE had indicated suicidal tendencies by attempting suicide on two occasions in 1961.
