Re Paris letter 10/15/59.

There is enclosed for the Bureau the original of a memorandum received in French on 11/4/59 from the Direction de la Surveillance du Territoire (DST), French domestic counterespionage service. This contains brief summaries of information from the files of the DST regarding individuals whose names were found in the address book of JOHN PITTMAN. (S)

The files of the Paris office are being searched regarding these names, and separate communications will be furnished on each individual on whom the Paris office has a file.

It is requested that the Bureau have this memorandum translated, and that a copy of the translation be furnished to this office.

It is noted that the French ask that they be advised if any of these individuals have been identified as Soviet agents. It is further noted that several of these individuals are identified by the DST as Soviet agents. It would be appreciated if the Bureau could furnish any pertinent information available to comply with the request of the DST. (S)
