Will display the photograph of THOMAS E. DAVIS to Officer HENRY PRZEDWORSKI to determine whether DAVIS is identical with the ROBERT C. HARRISON involved in instant wreck.

Will determine location of BENJAMIN W. DAVIS, formerly of 149 Ford Avenue, who may be identical with BENNIE DAVIS, brother of suspect DAVIS, and thereafter interview him regarding his knowledge of the activities of suspect DAVIS and concerning the theft and transportation of the 1948 Chevrolet stolen in Bluefield, West Virginia, February 3, 1952.

AT DEARBORN, MICHIGAN

Will display the photograph of DAVIS to ROBERT VAN RANST, 3539 Hipp Street, to determine whether DAVIS is identical with the person who claimed to be ROBERT C. HARRISON.

AT ECORSE, MICHIGAN

Will display the photograph of DAVIS to L. E. PATTON, General Manager, Evans Motor Sales, and other persons at the motor sales, who may have seen DAVIS to determine whether he is the individual who claimed to be THOMAS E. DAVIS or ROBERT C. HARRISON.

AT DETROIT MICHIGAN

Will furnish the Atlanta Office results of requested investigation, and for Atlanta to reinterview THOMAS E. DAVIS, U.S. Penitentiary, Atlanta, Ga.
