THOMAS EBOLI, also known as Tommy Ryan, Tommy Rye

On April 15, 1964, the Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, advised as follows:

THOMAS EBOLI, also known as Tommy Rye, Tommy Ryan, was born June 13, 1911, at Scisciano (Italy), the son of LUIGI and MADDALENA MADDALONI. The family of EBOLI is now completely extinct.

MARIA MADDALONI, a sister of EBOLI's wife, currently lives in Scisciano. She is married to PASQUALE ALVINO, son of SALVATORE, born in 1902, an invalid who was formerly a carpenter.

SALVATORE ALVINO, age 36, a son of MARIA MADDALONI, also a carpenter, is not known to have any criminal record.

There is no indication that the above persons have any contact with THOMAS EBOLI, although they are known to have received gift packages from America shortly after the war.

Further, there is no indication that EBOLI has any contact with any other persons in Italy.

There is no record of EBOLI in the files of the Italian National Police or in their identification files.
