Anti-racketeering investigations have been opened on DOMINICK ALONGI, DOM J. FERRARO, JOHN RIGGI, JOHN RUSSO and ROBERT TARANTINO, who are now reported to be members of Cosa Nostra.

Inasmuch as there are only a few additions and deletions in the New Jersey membership, a complete roster is not being set out in this report.

This case is again being placed in a pending inactive status with the next report to be submitted in six months, or sooner if warranted.
