ReRomelet, 3-26-64, and Bulet, 12-5-63, captioned "La Cosa Nostra; AR - Conspiracy."

By report received May 7, 1964, Dr. ARISTIDE MANOPULO, Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy, furnished the following additional information regarding the subject:

The records of the Office of Vital Statistics, Castellammare del Golfo, Italy, reflect that BONANNO was single, that he had no brothers or sisters, and that his parents were deceased. These records further reflect that there is presently residing in that city GIOVANNI BONVENTRE, a cousin of BONANNO, who was formerly a U.S. citizen but who has reacquired Italian citizenship. No other relatives are known to reside in that city.

The criminal records for Castellammare del Golfo disclose no criminal record for BONANNO. It was indicated, however, that he came from a family having a criminal record and that his father was killed some 40 years ago by the Mafia.

It was not possible to determine if BONANNO has any connection with criminal elements; however, it was pointed out that when BONANNO arrived in Italy in 1957 he was in contact with persons connected, or suspected of connections with, the Mafia, such as FRANCESCO GAROFALO and GIOVANNI BONVENTRE.

Rome is continuing to follow this matter closely and any pertinent information developed will be promptly forwarded to Bureau and interested offices.
