SUBJECT: LA COSA NOSTRA
ANTI-RACKETEERING
CONSPIRACY

We have received a request from the Department for a list of all individuals named by former NY 3864-C-TE as members of La Cosa Nostra. This source was Alfredo Sanantonio, member of the Carlo Gambino "family" in this organization, who was the victim of a gang slaying in Brooklyn, New York, on July 11, 1963. Sanantonio had furnished us extremely valuable information on La Cosa Nostra, including the identities of a large number of its leaders and other members. In making this request, the Department did not specify what use they intend to make of such a list.

New York is now completing a summary report covering recent developments in the investigation of this organization across the country, which should contain some of the data requested by the Department. It was necessary that a few amendments be made in this report and when New York has completed these changes, the report will receive further careful review at the Bureau.

ACTION:

We are not disseminating material to the Department at this time on La Cosa Nostra. While we do not propose to give the Department a blow-by-blow account of information developed concerning this organization, nevertheless, since the Department does know we have been investigating, if approved, this voluminous report, after a lapse of time for careful review at the Seat of Government will be routinely disseminated to the Department.
