Department Attorney John J. Cassidy, Criminal Division, Department of Justice, has advised that information concerning this matter was given to him originally on a confidential basis by George Phillips, leader of the dissident group within Teamsters Local 560. Phillips said this information was received by him from a woman whose name he whild not disclose, who is employed as an accountant by Chapman Boat Works. So far as Mr. Cassidy knows neither Phillips nor his source is aware of the present whereabouts of the "Miss Kensington" which reportedly was moved from Chapman Boat Works by Salvatore Briguglio, business agent of Teamsters Local 560.

It is suggested that information concerning the owner of this boat and possibly information with respect to its present location may be available through the Coast Guard, since it is believed Coast Guard regulations require that boats of the reported size of the "Miss Kensington" be registered with that agency.

Department Attorney Cassidy has requested that no contact be made with George Phillips at this time nor should any investigation be conducted to identify the above-mentioned employee of Chapman Boat Works who reportedly was the source of Phillips' information. If the present whereabouts of the "Miss Kensington" cannot be determined through contact with the Coast Guard or

Investigation at Chapman Boat Works reflects that HENRY SPECHT, known to them as "BUTTERCUP", had berthed "Miss KENSINGTON", a 30-foot Chris Craft, there since September, 1960.

ANTHONY PROVENZANO had been known to go out on the boat on three or four occasions in 1961. The boat had been used very little in 1962 and had not been used until 8/9/63, when it was moved from Chapman's.

An outstanding bill against the boat for service and dockage in the amount of \$1827.62, was paid in cash at that time.

Chapman has no record of any identifying serial numbers or registration numbers of this boat and does not know the present whereabouts of the boator? A

Diligent effort is being made to determine the whereabouts of this boat and obtain sufficient data to trace the owners. If efforts to trace the beat in this manner are unsuccessful, it is contemplated that a direct contact will be made with SPECHT.
