For the information of the Philadelphia Office, reRowlet reflects that SCOPELLITI. the son of DOMENICO SCOPELLITI and MARIA FORTUNATA POLIMENI, born 1-1-35 at S. Stefano Aspromonte, Reggio Calabria, Italy, was one of twenty individuals against whom the Tribunal of Rome issued a warrant charging them with international traffic in narcotics. SCOPELLITI was listed as an Italian national residing in Canada.

On 5-31-67 the Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy, stated that the Canadian authorities have advised that the subject is presently incarcerated at the Lewisburg Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania.
