- On 2 April 1966 Arturo Gonzalez Gonzalez, also known as "El Pato", a leader of the Movimiento Revolucionario Frank Pais (MRFP, Frank Pais Revolutionary Movement), said that the MRFP was planning to make an attack in the very near future, possibly between 6 and 10 April, on the oil tanks of the Arechabala Refinery, located on the shore of the Bay of Cardenas, Matanzas Province.
- The MRFP has a 29-foot boat, named EL TERRIBLE, which has diesel engines. The group also possesses C3 explosives, primacord, detonators, a 50-caliber machine gun for which they are trying to get ammunition, and other weapons for its personnel.
- The following people are scheduled to participate in the raid: Cirilo Ginori, captain of the vessel; Manuel Quiza, a guide; Roberto Perez Fraga, a frogman; and Guillermo Ramirez and Luis Fernandez, both gunners.
- On 12 April Jorge Gutierrez Ulla, chief of information of the Movimiento Insurreccional de Recuperacion (MIRR, Insurreccional Movement for Revolutionary Recovery), said that the MIRR is planning two operations, the first of which will be to sabotage a ship of some nation which engages in trade with Cuba. The sabotage attempt will take place when the ship is in port at Miami or in Puerto Rico.
