PH 614-C-TE FURNISHED COPIES SIX LISTS OF NAMES TOTALING 53. SOURCE COPIED FROM LISTS IN BRUNO'S POSSESSION AND WERE DRAWN UP IN CONNECTION SEATING ARRANGEMENTS JEAN BRUNO'S WEDDING DINNER. NAMES BELIEVED GROUPED EITHER BY ACTIVITIES OR REGIMES. ACCORDING TO PH 623C\* LISTS DRAWN UP AFTER CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION BETWEEN BRUNO AND ASSOCIATES. LISTS ALMOST ENTIRELY FIRST NAMES AND NICKNAMES. BELIEVED THEY CONSTITUTE FIRST AVAILABLE RECORD OF NAMES OF AMICI NOSTRI IN PHILA. AND SOUTHERN NEW JERSEY AREA.

LISTS WILL BE REVIEWED AND ANALYZED. PH 614-C-TE WILL BE INTERVIEWED FOR HIS INTERPRETATION OF PURPOSE AND IDENTITIES. WILL BE REPORTED IN DETAIL AT EARLIEST POSSIBLE DATE. BRUNO CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.
