The Las Vegas Office advised that ROSELLI checked into the Desert Inn Hotel on 7/9/65 and on that date made a telephone call to Los Angeles telephone 275-2981 and talked to a HELEN (LNU) for 62 minutes. HELEN may be HELEN GRECO, widow of musician "SPIKE" JONES. [redacted] PCI, furnished information on 7/15/65 that ROSELLI no longer is keeping company with NANCY CZAR and has proposed marriage to HELEN GRECO who he (ROSELLI) knew before she married JONES. [redacted] also learned that NANCY CZAR is quite displeased with ROSELLI at the present time and had made the statement that he is a "bag man" for interests in Las Vegas and that she made many trips with ROSELLI. Consideration is being given to an interview of CZAR in the near future.

On 7/13/65 information was received from the LAPD that ROSELLI and MAURICE H. FRIEDMAN arrived in Los Angeles from Las Vegas on WAL at about 11:45 AM on 7/13/65 and left the airport in a Lincoln automobile bearing California license RBE 885. Records of DMV, Los Angeles, reflect that California license RBE 885 is registered to Tru-Bor Manufacturing Company, 3520 Wesley Street, Culver City, California. No information is known at this time concerning this company.

On 7/16/65 [redacted] PCI, advised that ROSELLI is currently residing at his apartment; that ROSELLI's girl

friend, NANCY CZAR, moved from ROSELLI's apartment sometime during the latter part of June, 1965, and no longer lives there. Informant has no knowledge that any other woman is living at ROSELLI's apartment at the present time.

On the afternoon of 7/16/65 information was received from the LAPD that ROSELLI left Los Angeles for Las Vegas at about 3:00 PM on this date via Western Airlines. ROSELLI was alone.

LA 4145-C advised on 7/15/65 that ROSELLI had recently contacted AL PARVIN who owns a considerable interest in the Dohrman Hotel Supply Company for the purpose of convincing PARVIN to have the Dohrman company purchase more refrigeration equipment from Ajax West Coast Corp. FRANZ BREITLING, a close friend of ROSELLI, is president of Ajax and ROSELLI purchases refrigeration equipment from the company for resale. According to informant, BREITLING met with PARVIN on 7/13/65 to discuss this matter. PARVIN was willing to buy more equipment from Ajax but was not certain that he had sufficient control in the company to persuade the buyers to use Ajax equipment exclusively because in many instances other makes of equipment would be specified. However, PARVIN and BREITLING will continue to work on this matter. Informant said that when some agreement is reached between them, ROSELLI will receive a three per cent commission of the gross sales made by Ajax to the Dohrman Company. Informant estimated that if Ajax got all of Dohrman's refrigeration equipment business the total yearly sales would be about \$500,000.
