INSPECTOR DONNELLY ADVISED ON TWELVE NINETEEN
SIXTY SEVEN THAT BASED ON ABOVE INFORMATION FRANK MISTRELLA
AND ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL WERE ARRESTED FOR LOITERING
IN FRONT OF THE ABOVE BUILDING ON TWELVE FIFTEEN SIXTY
SEVEN. ON TWELVE SIXTEEN SIXTY SEVEN, MISTRELLA AND
FOURTEEN OTHERS WERE ARRESTED FOR GAMBLING AT THE ABOVE
ADDRESS. HE STATED THIS GAME WAS DOING TWENTY THOUSAND
DOLLARS A WEEK BUSINESS.

INSPECTOR DONNELLY ADVISED HE WOULD MAKE AVAILABLE
TO THE NYO THE IDENTITIES OF THE INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED
AT THE GAME. HE EXPRESSED HIS APPRECIATION FOR THE
COOPERATION OF THE NYO IN THIS MATTER.
