Although we concluded that prosecutive action was not warranted in the present circumstances, we noted that the Federal Aviation Agency had under consideration the question of the possible imposition of civil penalties under the Federal Aviation Act of 1958 and the regulations pursuant thereto. We are informed that the Federal Aviation Agency has revoked Frank Fiorini's pilot's certificate by order dated May 26, 1960, and 🦠 has imposed a fine of \$1000 upon Pedro Luis Diaz Lanz. The Agency advises that Diaz Lanz has tendered a check for \$250, but pleads poverty and desires to pay the balance of the fine in installments.
