Enclosed for the Bureau are seven copies of a letterhead memorandum, two of which are for information in the STUART SUTOR case, Bureau file 52-72398, and five are for captioned case. It is requested that copies of this memorandum be furnished to the United States Department of Justice, General Crimes Section, Attention LOUIS SCALZO. Also enclosed are information copies for the Miami, New York and Pittsburgh Divisions in this case and the STUART SUTOR case in which they have an interest.

It is noted that on May 17, 1960, Assistant United States Attorney JAMES B. PARSONS was in telephonic contact with LOUIS SCALZO, United States Department of Justice, concerning prosecutive decisions in this case. On that date, according to Mr. PARSONS, Mr. SCALZO was briefly apprised of the facts as set forth in the enclosed memorandum after which Mr. SCALZO requested that he be furnished with a memorandum concerning this interview in order to consider its value.
