By note delivered on 4-28-59 [Lt. Colonel EMILIO DELGADO, Internal Security Branch of the Information Section of the Spanish High General Staff] requested to be furnished with any background available on the subject. It is to be noted that there have been reports that subject is to be the Cuban Military Attache in Madrid, although Colonel DONALD B. WEBBER, Embassy Army Attache, advises that the Spanish Government has received no notification of the designation of subject as the Cuban Military Attache here. Colonel WEBBER did advise that he had received information from the U. S. Army Attache in Havana that the latter had been informed that CUBELA is to be the Cuban Military Attache in Madrid.

Re Madrid letter 4-29-59.

The 6-17-59 issue of the Madrid daily newspaper "A.B.C." carried a news item datelined at Havana to the effect that FIDEL CASTRO had made three new appointments in his government. One of the appointments mentioned was the naming of Major ROLANDO CUBELA to be Sub-Secretary of the Ministry of the Interior. This would indicate that CUBELA will not be the Cuban Military Attaché in Madrid.

Two extra copies of this letter are attached for forwarding by the Bureau to Havana. This matter will be maintained in a pending status in the Madrid Office awaiting a reply from Havana regarding background information on the subject which may be furnished to Lt. Colonel EMILIO DELGADO, Internal Security Branch of the Information Section of the Spanish High General Staff. (S)
