On May 26, 1964 a representative of the American Express Company, Paris, France, advised that the records of the Grand Hotel, Paris, indicated that subject arrived as a guest of this hotel on May 5, 1964 and departed on May 12, 1964. Source further advised that Paris police records indicated subject was bearer of U. S. passport #D092577 issued to him at New Orleans, USA. His passport reflected that he was born August 15, 1923 in the USA.

[The Paris Office is requesting any available information concerning subject from the Prefecture of Police, Renseignements Generaux (general investigative section), Surete National (RGSN) and the Service de Documentation Exterieur et de Contre-Espionnage (SDECE), French foreign intelligence and counterespionage service.] The Paris Office is also (S) requesting information from the Directorate General of Security and the Spanish High General Staff. The results of these inquiries to the French and Spanish authorities will be furnished to the Bureau and office of origin when received. (S)
