Reference is made to Bureau letter to Memphis dated December 23, 1957, forwarding a letter dated November 12, 1957, from ALBERT C. LAYMAN received from the Office of Security, Central Intelligence Agency. Reference is further made to Detroit letter to Bureau dated March 28, 1958.

On April 16, 1958, while at the Federal Correctional Institution, Milan, Michigan, on other matters, inmate ORA HENRY J. CARL was interviewed by SA CASPER H. KAST at the inmate's request. He furnished SA KAST a nine page handprinted document, handprinted in substitution cipher using Greek letters to represent letters of the English alphabet. He also furnished SA KAST with a slip of paper setting out the Greek letters used with their English alphabet equivalent. Decoded copies of instant message are attached. It is noted that the first part of the message is dated October 6, 1957, and addressed to "CIA Mr. DYLLLES, DIR." The second part of the message is directed to FBI and dated April 2, 1958. For your information, CARL insisted that the interview be brief.

On May 22, 1958, inmate CARL was contacted at the Federal Correctional Institution, Milan, Michigan, in full accordance with procedures followed in contacting inmates of this institution.

Concerning the enclosed message, CARL was interviewed in detail. It appears that all the information in his possession either comes from conversation he overhears in the hospital at the Federal Correctional Institution, Milan, Michigan, or from information he reads in the newspapers and is not based on his own knowledge or reliable hearsay information.

Concerning paragraphs 2, 3 and 4, page 1 of the enclosed message, CARL claims that the information he there reports is his opinion of "how the Italian inmates at FCI, Milan, feel."
