Her friendship with JUAN CASTINEIRAS helped her in having her husband, PAGES, released from prison and also arranged for her to obtain a permit authorizing her travel in Miami, where she asked for asylum for her husband, PAGES. She was in Miami in August, 1959, for about one month. While in Cuba she associates with followers of WILLIAM ALEXANDER MORGAN, former Toledo, Ohio character who was one of FIDEL CASTRO's leaders in the Cuban Revolution.
