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DECLASTIFICATION

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Synopsis:

Subject advised he had ceased his association with Alianza de Liberacion (AL), a unity of several anti-FIDEL CASTRO organizations, over a disagreement with one of the other leaders of AL, and so far as he is concerned, his group, the Cuban Constitutional Crusade (CCC), is dissolved. He said he is now associated with the Frente Revolucionario Democratico (FRD), a prominent unity of several anti-CASTRO organizations, and intends to act in the anti-CASTRO movement in the future only in conjunction with FRD.

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DETAILS:

On November 2, 1960, MM T-1 advised that RICARDO CANETE, a leader in the Cuban Nationalist Association (CNA), an anti-FIDEL CASTRO group in New York City was in contact on that date with JOSE VAZQUEZ, an Attache at the

Cuban Consulate New York City. According to MM T-1, CANETE advised VAZQUEZ that his group had received an order signed by the group's secretary, FELIPE RIVERO. to the effect that his group was to report in about ten days to a hidden camp in the Miami, Florida, area at which location ample arms and men were being assembled. advised VAZQUEZ his group was to coordinate with one Captain KCHINEA (ph) and one DIAZ LANZ in the Miami area. He indicated that other organizations included in this operation were Organizacion De Cubanos Anticomunistas De Nueva York (OCANY), the Accion Cubana Institucionalista (ACI), and a group from New Jersey which CANETE believed was called La Crosah (ph) .[\$]

On November 3, 1960, IGNACIO ROBERTO NOVO SAMPOL, the Secretary General of CNA, advised SA VINCENT J. WARGER that the last meeting he had attended pertaining to anti-CASTRO activities was a meeting which took place in New York City at the residence of a member of the Frente Revolucionario Democratico (FRD), a unity of several anti-CASTRO organizations which has become quite prominent in the anti-CASTRO movement. This meeting occurred during the week of October 28, 1960. As a result of this meeting, NOVO advised the CNA had decided not to join with FRD and was thinking of siding with the Alfanza de Liberacion (AL), a unity of several anti-CASTRO organizations, which will be further described below. Novo stated that during the week prior to that time, FELIPE XIVERO DIAZ met with PEDRO DIAZ LANZ and one Captain CHINEA who, according to NOVO, was a representative of the anti-CASTRO group headed by LUIS CONTE AGUERO. NOVO stated FELIPE RIVERO was to notify him in about two weeks of his decision with regard to joining with the AL. NOVO stated he knew nothing of the plans regarding the AL to date.

On November 9, 1960, subject advised SA RICHARD B. KELLOGG that several months ago he associated himself with exiled former Cuban radio commentator LUIS CONTE AGUERO, a portion of the anti-CASTRO group known as Movimiento Recuperacion Revolucionario (MRR), and some groups in the New York City area, one of which was the group identified with Cuban
