Re Mexico City airtel and LHM dated 11/5/68.

It is noted that the report of FRANCIS E. GIBBONS made at Miami on 11/9/68 had a lead for Legat, Mexico City, to obtain descriptive data regarding IACB weapons and ammunition in the possession of the subjects from authorities at Belize, British Honduras. [This lead is considered to have been covered by the MI 5 report dated 11/26/68 which was included in SA GIBBONS' report dated 1/9/69] (C)

The Mexico City Office has been attempting to obtain through American Consulate in Merida, Yucatan, information concerning the results of the inquiries Mexican authorities conducted regarding IACB activities in Yucatan. (U)

On 1/17/69 Vice Consul DONALD J. YELLMAN of Merida advised they had not yet obtained the information, but would renew their request. (U)

The Bureau will be furnished any data which is developed. (U)
