Referenced letter enclosed material reflecting
that the Government of Mexico would not make available to
the State Department expert witnesses to testify in captioned
matter, and that the State Department considers the case
closed. ACU

Referenced letter set out that successful prosecution
in this matter was dependent upon the testimony of Mexican
police officials, that prosecution was no longer contemplated
due to the above Mexican Government decision, and that the
Department was requesting no further investigation in this
matter. ACU

As above precludes further investigation, this
case is being placed in a closed status. It is noted that
the Department is currently contemplating prosecution of
FIORINI in the Miami case captioned "INTERNATIONAL ANTI-
COMMUNIST BRIGADE (IACB), aka; FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, aka;
FRANK ANGELO FIORINI; ET AL" (Bufile 2-172694; Miami file
2-192).
