T-1, who has furnished reliable information in the
past, advised on February 13, 1963:

¹ TERESA PROENZA PROENZA, Third Secretary, Cuban
Embassy, Mexico City, has been involved in Communist activities
for many years. She was formerly the secretary of the well-
known Mexican Communist painter DIEGO RIVERA.

PROENZA is regarded as being a loyal Communist
rather than a loyal follower of Premier FIDEL CASTRO of Cuba.
PROENZA has given no indication that she is not completely
faithful to the present regime in Cuba.

EUSEBIO AZCUE of the Cuban Consulate in Mexico City
recently made these comments: (S) (u)

TERESA PROENZA has been very critical of RAMON
SINOBAS, First Secretary and Charge d'Affaires in the absence
of Cuban Ambassador to Mexico CARLOS LECHUGA. PROENZA charges
that SINOBAS is young, inexperienced, and unqualified for such
an important assignment. (S) (u)

According to AZCUE, one of the reasons for the trip
to Cuba in late December, 1962, by PROENZA was to urge that
SINOBAS be replaced. AZCUE is of the opinion that PROENZA,
who remains in Cuba at the present time, will use her influence
with the Cuban Communist leader ELIAS BOCA and RAUL CASTRO, the
Cuban Minister of Defense, to obtain the appointment as
Charge d'Affaires in the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City for
PROENZA. (S) (u)
