Attached is a list of names of FBI agents who conducted interviews of defendants and co-conspirators, most of whom will Vbe called to give testimony at the trial. Usually two agents participated in an interview and under normal circumstances only one of these would be needed for trial testimony. In this case, however, the attorney in charge of the case has indicated that he would prefer to see both agents in advance of the time of testifying for purposes of preparation and, if possible, would prefer to have both present while the principal witnesses testify in the event the other is needed. In order to cause as little interference as possible with the other duties of the agents involved, it is requested that you authorize the individual agents to contact Mr. Milton R. Wessel, Special Assistant to the Attorney General, United States Court House, Foley Square, New York City, Courtland 7-7100, in order to arrange a time and date of interview which is mutually convenient. With the commencement of the trial itself Mr. Wessel will prepare a schedule of the estimated dates when the various agents. will be required for the purpose of giving testimony. In the event that for some reason any of the listed agents will not be available for interview prior to October 19, or for the purpose of giving testimony at the trial, it is requested that we be so advised as soon as possible.
