NY FIVE ZERO FOUR TWO - C-TE ADVISED ON TEN, TEN, SIXTY EIGHT, THAT THE BLACKJACK GAME OPERATED BY TOM PALMER AND JOE LEFTY, BOTH MEMBERS OF THE GENOVESE "FAMILY" HAD REOPENED AT NINETY-FIVE SECOND AVENUE, NEW YORK CITY. INFORMANT ADVISED HE KNEW OF NO INTERSTATE ASPECT TO THIS OPERATION. ON THE SAME DATE THE ABOVE INFORMATION WAS FURNISHED TO INSPECTOR ED DONNELLY, NYCPD.

INSPECTOR DONNELLY ADVISED ON TEN SEVENTEEN, SIXTY EIGHT, THAT BASED ON THE ABOVE INFORMATION, THE ABOVE GAME WAS RAIDED ON TEN THIRTEEN, SIXTY EIGHT, AND FOURTEEN PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FOR GAMBLING. HE STATED THIS GAME WAS DOING APPROXIMATELY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS A DAY BUSINESS. HE ADVISED
