On 9/13/67, Agent ARNOLD BEDDINGFIELD, Intelligence Division, IRS, Washington, D. C., advised SA LEWIS that a search of the records of his department failed to reflect any information identifiable with MARSHAL.

A review of WFO files concerning MARSHAL disclosed no additional information concerning MARSHAL not previously furnished by referenced Dallas airtel or referenced Bureau letter.
