closed.Referenced letter set out that successful prosecution
in this matter was dependent upon the testimony of Mexican
police officials, that prosecution was no longer contemplated
due to the above Mexican Government decision, and that the
Department was requesting no further investigation in this
matter.As above precludes further investigation, this
case is being placed in a closed status. It is noted that
the Department is currently contemplating prosecution of
FIORINI in the Miami case captioned "INTERNATIONAL ANTI-
COMMUNIST BRIGADE (IACB), aka; FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, aka;
FRANK ANGELO FIORINI; ET AL" (Bufile 2-172694; Miami file

There is attached for your information a copy of a letter, together with the enclosure thereto, from the Director, Office of Munitions Control, dated March 5, 1969 and addressed to Mr. John H. Davitt, of this Division. You will note that the attached material reflects that the Government of Mexico would not accede to the request of the State Department to make available expert witnesses to testify in the captioned matter, and that the State Department considers the case closed.

It is our opinion that the testimony of Mexican police officials would be essential to a successful prosecution in this matter. Accordingly, we do not contemplate prosecution, and we are not requesting any further investigation in this matter.
