CG 6486-C\* ADVISED OVER PAST WEEKEND THAT EDWARD VOGEL WAS IN VICINITY OF INFORMANT, INQUIRING AS TO WHEREABOUTS OF GIANCANA, WAS TOLD BY DOMINIC BLASI THAT HE (GIANCANA) IS AWAY, WILL BE BACK MONDAY. PCI [REDACTED] ADVISED THAT CONSIDERABLE ACTIVITY HAS TAKEN PLACE AT THE ARMORY LOUNGE DURING PAST SEVERAL DAYS, HOWEVER, GIANCANA NOT OBSERVED. CG 6486-C\* ADVISED THAT MOST OF ACTIVITY DESCRIBED BY PCI ABOVE CONSISTED OF PRIVATE PARTIES, NOT PERTINENT TO INVESTIGATION. ARMED AND DANGEROUS. (u)
