Included in details of instant report is an FD-302 and an insert reflecting investigation conducted by auxiliary offices but had been inadvertently omitted from previous report.

On 7/21/67, NO 1285 - C advised SA ROGER A. BOMBARDIER that on Monday night, 7/17/67, he attended the fight program at Municipal Auditorium in New Orleans, where FRANK CARACCI was observed at ringside taking bets. Informant advised that after the fight, CARACCI was surrounded by several people attempting to either pay off or collect on their bets, at which time CARACCI stated that no one should give him any money now as people were watching him. LA

Informant advised that HASKELL JONES was also at ringside but that he did not observe him taking any bets.
