Upon receipt of referenced airtel, temporary stops were placed with INS at Brownsville, Texas, on FRANK ANGELO FIORINI, aka FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, pursuant to the request made in reairtel.

Liaison was established with the U. S. Customs Agency Service in Brownsville and with General JAVIER GONZALEZ, Chief of Customs, in Matamoros, Tamaulipas, Mexico. General GONZALEZ was also furnished with the names of associates of FIORINI. & (u)

General GONZALEZ was last contacted on 11/12/68; B. J. COCHRAN, Assistant Customs Agent in Charge, was last contacted on 11/14/68; and CHARLES VAIL, Officer in Charge, INS, was last contacted on 11/14/68, all with negative results. Both VAIL and COCHRAN pointed out that they do not check outbound traffic to Mexico. VAIL added that an American returning from Mexico by automobile seldom has his name checked against the stop list if the officer whom he first contacts as he crosses the bridge is satisfied that the Thousands of Americans cross the Border person is a citizen. returning to the United States daily.
