Washington Field Office (WFO) has recommended four technical coverage on Nicaraguan Embassy be discontinued. Recommend WFO be instructed to continue coverage for additional 60 days (S)

DETAILS:

By communication dated 2/14/63 WFO advised it would discontinue technical coverage on Nicaraguan Embassy 2/21/63 unless contrary instructions received from Bureau. According to WFO, coverage produced only four items of general interest since 12/11/62. (Actually five items have been received, the last on 2/16/63.) (S)

Two of the items referred to by WFO concerned rather clandestine arrangements for a trip to New York City by the Vice President of El Salvador, who was ready to talk directly and in private to Ben. The significance of this information is unknown to us but appears to be the type of data that could well be of particular significance to State Department and CIA, to whom it was furnished. (S)

This coverage produced information 2/11/63 that an official of Nicaraguan Embassy and P. Irving Davidson, registered agent of Nicaragua, were concerned about two checks, one of which was cashed by "Flood." Davidson suggested that probably "Flood" merely cashed it for "Frank." In light of what appeared in 2/13/63 Drew Pearson column, it appears this may well have amounted to recommendation by Davidson as to manner Nicaragua should answer any inquiries concerning the check. Pearson's column alleged that Nicaragua, through registered agent Frank Barry, had made two contributions to 1960 United States election campaigns. One was \$10,000 to President Kennedy's campaign, of which Kennedy knew nothing, and the other was to campaign of Representative Daniel J. Flood (D) of Pennsylvania. We furnished this information to Attorney General, as well as Assistant Attorneys General in charge of Criminal and Internal Security Divisions. (S)

OBSERVATIONS:

Nicaragua is one of countries which has operated through registered agents in this country. Senate Foreign Relations Committee is currently conducting inquiries into activities of foreign agents. For this reason, and in view of nature of information received from this source 2/11/63, now is not the opportune time to eliminate this coverage. (S)
