For the information of the Bureau, case files are open in the Miami Office concerning all organizations mentioned in instant report.

It is noted that T-symbols and sources were not used in all instances where information was set forth. This was to make this intelligence-type report more readable, in view of reBulet January 14, 1960, which calls for a succinct summary of major organizations and groups.

Bureau will note im Section III of this report that the establishment of a junta for political leadership of the movement is as yet not settled. However, ROLANDO MASFERRER, on February 25, 1960, said that MARQUEZ STERLING is now the political leader, and that Colonel SANCHEZ MOSQUERA will soon become the military leader, because the "Batistianos" fear General PEDRAZA's ambitions, and the ex-"FIDELISTAS" and Authentic Party will not accept PEDRAZA.

This information is not being included in the losed * report, inasmuch as it has not yet been confirmed or received * from any other source.

Synopsis: There are about 70,000 Cuban nationals in Miami. have been clashes between pro and anti-CASTRO groups. There are four anti-CASTRO organizations in Miami and two in New York. ADC, CCC, MAOC, and MGA are in Miami. OCANY and WHITE ROSE are in New York. In 1959 NUNEZ PORTUONDO was considered political leader of the opposition groups. In December, 1959, General TRUJILDO of Dominican Republic and WILLIAM D. PAWLEY of Miami reportedly said they would support a junta to govern Cuba. PORTUONDO threatened to retire from movement. There were subsequent meetings in United States to establish unity of opposition groups, but no indication that a junta was established. Leading individuals are: NUNEZ PORTUONDO, FERNANDEZ MIRANDA, MASFERRER ROJAS, PIEDRA NEGUERUELA, BOSQUE CUETO, ALIEGRO MILA, DIAZ LANZ, and General PEDRAZA. GARCIA NAVARRO and FREYRE AGUILERA do not expect invasion of Cuba by movement without United States support. Base in Dominican Republic reportedly has about 1,000 European mercenaries and 100 Cubans. PAUL JOSEPH HUGHES, MATT DUKE, and (FNU) PINKSTON believed involved in bombing missions over Cuba. Propaganda by movement is by radio, newspaper "Cuba Libre" and pamphlets.

Reference is made to the report of Special Agent ROBERT JAMES DWYER, dated and captioned as above at Miami, Florida.

MM T-1 is a Cuban national, head of an anti-CASTRO organization, and in contact with many leaders of opposition groups. Insufficient contact has been had with MM T-1 to determine his reliability, but he is in an excellent position to furnish accurate information.

MM T-2 is an American citizen who is in a position to furnish reliable information.

MM T-3 is a former Cuban government official who claims to have numerous contacts with Cuban nationals in the United States.

MM T-4 is a former Cuban political leader, with whom insufficient contact has been had to determine his reliability, but who is in an excellent position to furnish reliable information.

MM T-5 is a former Cuban government official
