On November 28, 1966, a confidential informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that he had heard the collowing from I. Irving Davidson:

Davidson on November 28, 1966, contacted trace The All ran Dassador to the United States gand informed Theen that on that morning he had received a visit from two gentlemen from Miami, one of whom he identified as a man named Rojas (phonetic). Davidson was not aware of the identity of the second individual.

Continuing, Davidson said that he told Theard the above two individuals had been telling him some stories about a meeting which had been held the previous evening in Miami and which concerned a new invasion of Haiti to be held in twelve to fifteen days. Davidson noted that his own Spanish was not too good and that these two individuals apparently had a lot of facts that Davidson did not understand.

Davidson informed Theard that the above two individuals wanted to talk to Theard and were "looking for some help. Davidson indicated to the informant that he told Theard

information had previously been received from the above individuals but had proven to be of no interest. They now were in possession of new information and Davidson is of the opinion that they are to take part in the invasion. Davidson also indicated to the informant that he had suggested to Theard that because he, Davidson, was unable to evaluate the information that Theard could send Staco (phonetic) to talk to the above individuals.

The informant subsequently heard through Davidson that Theard Intended to send a Colonel to speak with the above individuals and cautioned Davidson that they should not know the Colonel's identity. Davidson indicated he would introduce the Colonel as a personal friend.

In regard to Staco mentioned above, it is noted that the 'Diplomatic List' Gated August 2966, published by the United States Department of State Wijsts Colonel Nerva Staco as Military, Naval and Air Attache of the Embassy of Haitil

The position of Andre Theard as previously mentioned was confirmed through the same Diplomatic List. (x) (u)

On November 28, 1966, Ulda Poland, Registration Section, Internal Security Division, United States Department of Justice, advised that I. Irving Davidson is registered with the Department of Justice as an agent for the Government of Haiti, among others.

In regard to the above, it is also noted that on November 23, 1966, I. Irving Davidson advised a representative of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that one Arsenio Rojas, then in Miami, Florida, was a "part of the invasion" of Haiti which was to be undertaken on November 23, 1966. Davidson
