RE: INTERNATIONAL ANTI-COMMUNIST BRIGADE (IACB)  
ALSO KNOWN AS  
ORGANIZACION EJERCITO SECRETO DE LA  
BRIGADA INTERNACIONAL ANTI-COMUNISTA  
(SECRET ARMY ORGANIZATION OF THE  
INTERNATIONAL ANTI-COMMUNIST BRIGADE)

Reference is made to my memorandum dated October 8, 1968, with enclosure, which dealt with the activities of the captioned anti-Castro group which is headed by Frank Fiorini who has long been involved in anti-Castro activities.

The "Miami News," a Miami, Florida, newspaper, on October 25, 1968, carried an article captioned "Miami Invaders Held." It was indicated in this article that 13 men claiming to be from South Florida were being held by authorities in British Honduras. Four of these reportedly claimed they were from Miami and nine stated that they were from Broward County, Florida, and Vero Beach, Florida. According to the article, the police at Belize, British Honduras, said that the men told them they were "going to Cuba." Police also found an arms cache, ammunition, medical supplies and anticommunist literature.
