unfeasible. Bear in mind Morris reportedly has a gun in his
possession. Identify the Inter-American Business Corporation
and determine if Frank Fiorini, the subject of a pending
investigation in your office, is connected with it. Furnish
pertinent data to Customs locally.

Be alert for an indication expedition being formed,
bearing in mind possibility of violation of neutrality statutes
within Bureau's jurisdiction.

Swamp in form suitable for dissemination.

Ottawa advised RCMP inquiry being made and pertinent
results will be made available.

is one D. F. Lance. RCMP info indicates training camp was to be set up in Guatemala. RCMP advised info should be taken with considerable disbelief as subject previously had arranged for his own disappearance hoping it would be presumed he had been murdered by hitchhiker and thus enable him to start life anew with someone other than his wife. RCMP noted subject placed ad in Canadian paper looking for adventurers and commented he was type who would engage as mercenary soldier.
