A check of the records and logs at La Aurora Air-
port, San Jose, Costa Rica, on 7/25 and 26/73, failed to indicate
that a Grumman Gulfstream, Registration #N-7115, was currently
in San Jose and further that no such airplane had landed there
within the past 90 days.

Costa Rican police have made a comprehensive survey
of all aircraft used by ROBERT VESCO, who is currently under Federal
indictment in the U. S., and who has traveled extensively to and
from Costa Rica during the past year.

A check of the records with reference to VESCO
failed to indicate that he had at any time entered or left Costa
Rica in an aircraft identical with the Grumman Gulfstream,
Registry #N-7115.
