Reference is made to our memorandum dated April 14, 1961, entitled "Manuel Enrique Pereira."

On April 20, 1961, Mrs. Harlene Rae Worrow, 1490
Northwest 39th Street, Miami, Florida, advised that she has
known Antonic Perez, who is headwaiter on the SS "Florida,"
since January, 1961. She stated that Ferez and his friend
Manuel Pereira are definitely pro-Castro and have continually
expressed sympathy for the Cuban Government and dislike for
the attitude of the United States toward Cuba. She advised
that on one occasion Perez and she went to a restaurant in
Nassau, Bahamas, where they met a Guban who taught physical
education in a public school in Nassau. According to
Mrs. Worrow, this teacher was very much pro-Castro.
