DAILY SUMMARY. RE ARMORY LOUNGE. CG 6533-C ADVISED THAT ON SUNDAY, JUNE 10 LAST, GIANCANA WAS OBSERVED AT ARMORY, SHORTLY THEREAFTER, JOSEPH CORTINO, CHIEF OF POLICE, FOREST PARK, ILLINOIS, APPEARED AND WENT INSIDE. ACCORDING TO INFORMANT, ONLY TWO PERSONS THERE WERE GIANCANA AND CORTINO. INFORMANT HAD PRETEXT CONVERSATION WITH DOMINIC BLASI, GIANCANA LIEUTENANT, WHO ADVISED THAT THE NEW LICENSE FOR THE ARMORY IS IN THE NAME OF CARMEN FANELLI'S WIDOW. IT WAS NOT REVEALED TO INFORMANT AS TO IDENTITY OF PERSON WHO WILL HAVE CONTROL OVER THE NEW ESTABLISHMENT. (u)
