SUBJECT: RELATIONS WITH SECRET SERVICE  
THREATS AGAINST THE PRESIDENT

ReBulet to Legat, Bern, 11/19/64.

As RCMP has sole responsibility for security of visiting dignitaries in Canada and maintains a surveillance booklet setting out identities, background and capabilities of persons who might embarrass the Government by activities during such visits, the writer contacted Superintendent W. G. Fraser, Assistant Director, Criminal Investigations, RCMP Headquarters, on December 1, 1964. Legat was subsequently advised the booklet is under review and procedure being revised for handling. It is planned to issue cards on each individual in a color code system which will prevent necessity for periodic revisions of the book. This review should be completed in January, 1965, at which time copy of same and subsequent amendments will be made available to this office for referral to the Bureau. (C)

From contacts with Superintendent Fraser and members of the Directorate of Security and Intelligence, it is known this will contain all such individuals, including those with security backgrounds. (C)

It is Legat's understanding that letterhead memoranda on security index subjects, including those residing outside the United States, have been prepared by the office of origin. If this is not correct, please advise in order that appropriate letterhead memoranda may be prepared.
