On 2/20/62, subject was asked about MERIDEL LE SUEUR (Bufile 100-105909), who had recently been in Cuerna-vaca, Mexico. Subject told them that LE SUEUR should not vaca, be contacted and that any messages could be sent through her.

The same date, she mentioned that her citizenship papers had not been signed.

Informants reported 3/15/62 that subject was collecting money for a school to be sponsored by the Mexican Communist Party (PCM) to train leaders from all over Mexico.
