ON 8/16/67, [NY 5812-S*] contact with whom has been (s) insufficient to establish his reliability, advised that ["Kram"] (s) is the KGB code name for MARK LANE, a Lawyer and the author of a recent book critical of the findings of the Warren Commission in the assassination of President KENNEDY. The source stated that BORIS OREKHOV, a KGB Officer, assigned to the NY Residency, had had two meetings with LANE and had established a trusted relationship with him. [NY 5812-S*] (s) stated that subject had subsequently travelled to Europe but had not been contacted since his return to the US. (X)

[NY 5812-S*] stated that the NY Residency of the KGB (s) had established "conditions" of meetings with LANE. (X)

As a matter of information, BORIS M. OREKHOV, a Soviet national, was employed as the information officer, Office of Public Information, at the UN Secretariat, NYC. He last departed the US on 4/2/66. (X) (u)
