This report is being classified confidential in order to protect the identity of the informants of continuing value used therein and whose identity, if made known, could be prejudicial to the national defense interests.

The deposit of \$417.81 on 11/5/63, was reviewed by SA LITTLE and it was noted that the deposit was made up of numerous personal checks in small amounts - apparently in response to the appeal in the 10/21/63, BAFPCC newsletter for funds to aid the hurricane victims in Cuba.

The details of this report do not contain the information furnished 5/9/63, by NY 2440-S* concerning the allegation made by VINCENT THEODORE LEE to TOM LEONARD in Denver that ASHER HARER skimmed five thousand dollars from the BAFPCC film project and gave it to the SWP. This information is not being reported due to the complete coverage that was given to the BAFPCC film project, which was appropriately reported and indicated no malfeasance on the part of HARER, or anyone else, in the handling of these funds.
