On June 22, 1962, arrangements were made for Recoosin and William Baggs, Editor of the "Miami Daily Hows," to get in touch with each other. Recoosin subsequently arrived in Miami, indicating that White House representatives had contacted him and had asked him to go to Miami to contact Baggs, whom he described as President Kennedy's representative. (Recoosin stated that the White House doubted that the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) was giving the true picture of Cuban matters and Indicated that White House investigation of CIA operations was being conducted in Miami by Baggs. Recoosin was interested in contacting anti-Castro individuals, particularly those who had previously participated in CIA operations, and in having them made available to Baggs for interview (170)
