On 3-31-66 he was rated EXCELLENT and it was stated he continued in assignment on the S-1 Squad handling foreign intelligence, sabotage and related matters of a security nature. He was among the high producers in the office, his reports and other correspondence were accurate, he was enthus iastic, his cases were administered in a practically flawless manner and during the rating period he made a number of highly delicate interviews in an outstanding manner, showing considerable forcefulness tempered with discretion and good judgment. He could handle the most complicated investigative matters and required minimum of supervision. He had not proposed names of any applicants, but made a number of interviews and his efforts were considered satisfactory. On dangerous assignments he was alett, showed tremendous initiative and was an asset. He developed 1 Security Informant and had 2 Potentials under development. He was interested in, available for and considered completely qualified at this time for administrative advancement. His qualifications were considered Outstanding.

His daily average overtime for March, 1966 was 2 hours 33 minutes; April, 2 hours 6 minutes.

On 4-1-66 his SAC recommended he be designated a Relief Supervisor; however, by letter 5-6-66 he was advised SA Gheesling was not approved as such in view of the severe administrative action taken against him in the past.
