MEDAN departed WDC same date (MEDAN saw DAJANY again on 4/8/58. After meeting DAJANY about noon on that date (MEDAN) visited (International Bank) Building about 3:00 g.m., leaving building with newspaper folded under arm. (MEDAN) returned again to the building later in the evening and proceeded from there to the airport for departure to New York. On (5)4/18/58, MEDAN met DAJANY and they lunched together. On the evening of 4/18/58, MEDAN departed WDC via plane for NY stopping at Baltimore, Maryland. On 5/12/58, MEDAN again visited WDC and was in contact with unidentified male who rented an automobile in the name of (A. Protocol Records, State Department disclosed ASHER ABIR, Assistant Administrative Officer terminated employment at the Israeli Embassy, 12/13/56, presumably to return to Israel On 4/17/58, an informant reported knowing DAJANYS) since 1952. She advised she had indulged in sex acts with DAJANY on three or four occasions and described DAJANY as "queer with women." [DAJANN on 4/23 58, possibly visited 2912 North Stafford Street, Arlington, Va., the address determined to be the residence of JOSEPH W. SHIMON, Captain of Deectives, MPD. On 5/1958, DAJANY was observed in the vicinity of 31st Street, North Military Road, Arlington, Virginia, vicinity of SHIMON's residence, however, it could not be determined whether (DAJANY visited SHIMON's residence. DETAILS: AT WASHINGTON, D. C.

On March 27, 1958, Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (SAs of the FBI) observed RAFAEL MEDAN S Assistant Director of Press, Israeli Delegation to the United Nations as he arrived at Washington National Airport on Flight 345 of American Airlines at 10:37 a.m. to make a long distance telephone call to New York City collect to New York Number (TR 7-5380) and then departed the airport via taxi and proceeded to the Israeli Embassy At 12:52 p.m. (MEDAN) met OMAR DAJANY an employee of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development in the lobby of the Roger Smith Hotel. They lunched together during which time MEDAN was observed to take notes on a three by five card, apparently as a result of DAJANY's conversation. At one point DAJANY was observed to refer to some written matter which he took from an inside coat pocket. DAJANY appeared to do most of the talking and MEDAN did all of the writing. The three by five card was returned to an envelope type wallet which [MEDAN] kept in an inside coat pocket.

(DAJANY) left the hotel approximately 2:25 p.m. but returned shortly to pick up his topcoat which he had forgotten and after talking momentarily with MEDAN they again separated. MEDAN returned to the Israeli Embassy by taxicab and DAJANY returned to the International Bank, Building. At 5:25 p.m. same date, MEDAN proceeded by taxis to the airport and departed for New York via American Airlines, Flight 268, at 6:40 p.m./5)

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car parked almost directly in front of 2912 North Stafford Street, Arlington. At approximately 8:05 p.m. an individual, described similarly to DAJANY was observed sitting in front of a window inside of 2912 North Stafford. At 8:46 p.m. subject was observed sitting in his car conversing with an unidentified male standing beside the car. The unidentified male was described as six feet, slender build, no coat, dressed in white shirt, dark hair. Further description was unobtainable due to darkness. DAJANY departed from the above address at 8:46 p.m. alone.

The current address telephone directory for the Washington, D. C., area, disclosed that "JOS. W. SHIMON," was listed as a residente of 2912 North Stafford Street, Arlington, Virginia. On April 25, 1958, SA ROBERT H. KURTZMAN determined from the Metropolitan Police Department that JOSEPH W. SHIMON, who resides at 2912 North Stafford Street, Arlington, is a Captain of Detectives and is in charge of the General Investigations Squad.

On June 26 and 27, 1950, Lieutenant JOSEPH W. SHIMON, identical with the Captain of Detectives mentioned before, was interviewed by SAs JOHN C. NEELY and CHARLES M. BEALL, JR., in connection with another matter. SHIMON reported that he had tapped telephone wires at the Mayflower Hotel in 1947 during the Senate Investigation of HOWARD HUGHES, Head of Transworld Airlines.

On the morning of April 26, 1958, SAs of the FBI observed DAJANY as he visited 2204 Restreet, N. W., for approximately four minutes. He then visited the Pakistan Embassy residence, (2343 S) Street, N. W., where he was observed to enter carrying a small package and some flowes. Approximately fifteen minutes later, DAJANY sleft the above address with two unidentified males, all three entering a 1956 Cadillac bearing Diplomatic license Number (31) a chauffeur driven car.

A check of the District of Columbia registrations reflect that the above license and car is registered to the Ambassador of Pakistan (6)

On the same evening DAJANY was believed to enter (2204 R) Street, N. W., where he remained for several minutes. The address telephone directory for Washington, D. C., area lists (MOHAMED SHOAIB, 2204 R) Street, N. W. The "List of Employees of Diplomatic Missions" for (March), 1958, published
