Re Paris letter 9/15/64.

The Direction de la Surveillance du Territoire (DST), French domestic counterespionage service, advised on October 9, 1964, that it was ascertained from a reliable source that the captioned subject is in contact with a French national of Polish origin one, ARLETTE FRANCOS, also known as ANIA, born July 19, 1938 in Paris. She resides with her parents at 75 rue Turbigo, is a journalist by profession, and is well-known for her activities in communism and Castroism.

[The DST also noted] that information had been received indicating that BUCHANAN planned to depart France at the end of September or the beginning of October for the United States in order to prepare an article for the weekly journals "L'Express" of France and "Tempo" of Italy, regarding the Warren Commission report. BUCHANAN's address during his visit to the United States was given as in care of FRANCES GILMOR, 22 West Chase Street, Baltimore, Maryland.

There is enclosed for the information of the Bureau an article which appeared on pages 26 and 27 of "L'Express," of October 5 - 11, 1964, which is now a weekly news magazine.
