and LEVINE as associates and made reference to a letter he had previously written requesting an appointment to discuss Afro-Asian and Latin American matters. GOUGH was informed that an appointment would be arranged.

(WF 1501-S*) (S) [redacted] advised that GOUGH had telephonically contacted [the Moroccan Embassy] on 12/12/63, and had advised (S) I that he, BOYKIN, and LEVINE were going to be in Washington, D.C. from 1/13/64 to 1/18/64, and expressed the desire to have an appointment with (AMIE SOUSSANE) (S)

(WF 1575-S*) (S) [redacted] advised that on 1/20/64 GOUGH telephonically I contacted (BELKACEN ABDELAL) Commercial Attache at the (S) Algerian Embassy concerning an appointment and was told that he would see GOUGH, BOYKIN, and LEVINE at 11:00 A.M. on 1/22/64

(WF 1501-S*) (S) [redacted] advised that GOUGH called (the Moroccan (S) I Embassy) on 1/20/64 concerning an appointment with (SOUSSANE) (S) and was informed that (SOUSSANE) would see GOUGH, BOYKIN, and (S) LEVINE at 12:30 P.M. on 1/22/64.

(WF 1501-S*) (S) The above information obtained from [redacted] and [redacted] has not been included in the LHM because of the extremely sensitive nature of the informant. Such information should not be disseminated outside of the Bureau. I I

When such records are available, they will be reviewed in accordance with the department's request that such records be reviewed on a continuing monthly basis until the end of the present trial, which is being held in Chattanooga, Tenn.
