Information has been secured from KC 737-C\* that in early June, 1962, subject engaged in a very bitter and serious discussion with NICK CIVELLA at the Original Subject's complaint to NICK Toy & Jobbing Company. CIVELLA was based on the fact that he, CACIOPPO, believed that over the years he has not received his fair share of the income from the organized criminal element in KCMO. CIVELLA indicated to him that he had received his fair share and was still receiving it, but the only reason he had no tangible assets in property, etc., was because he. had lost his money gambling. CACIOPPO intimated that he was considering selling his home and leaving the Kansas City area. Investigation has established that subject was at Reno, Nevada, at the Riverside Hotel from 6-13-62 to 6-15-62.

On 7213-62, Major JOHN FLAVIN, KCMOPD, advised that officers had checked out CHUCKY MORGAN recently in the vicinity of subject's residence, and CHUCKY at that time indicated he had been checking the house periodically because subject was out of town on vacation in Buffalo, New York.

On 7-3-62, KC 315-C advised he had learned that subject has been in Las Vegas for the past four days. Informant was unable to furnish any specific information regarding this or the purpose of subject's trip to Las Vegas.

Information indicates subject is not known to have been in the Kansas City area since June, 1962, and the above represents the only information known as to his whereabouts during this period.

In view of the above, the writer has been unable to interview subject in connection with the Interview Program.
